Directions:

Satnav users enter Postcode EX6 8JA

From North and East (M5)

Leave at junction 30. Take A379 towards Exeter City Centre

After passing Ikea, filter left toward City Centre/Dawlish/Marsh

Barton/Topsham. At Countess Weir roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Bridge Rd/A379 and cross the swing bridge.

At the next roundabout turn left into Sannerville Way/A379 signposted Dawlish.

**In about 4½ miles go through the village of Kenton and the Victory Hall will be seen on the left (about ½ mile before Powderham Castle). Turn left into Sittercombe Lane and immediately left into Penhayes Road. The hall carpark is on the left.

From the South:

Leave the Devon Expressway (A38) on A380 signposted Torquay. At the Marsh Barton roundabout (the Devon Hotel) bear right. At the Matford roundabout turn right (Dawlish A379) and follow from ** above.

From the West:

Leave the A30 at the Alphington junction. Follow signs for Exeter to the first set of lights; turn left and follow signs for Dawlish (A379) through Marsh Barton. At the Marsh Barton roundabout (the Devon Hotel) bear left At the Matford roundabout turn right (Dawlish A379) and follow from ** above.
