**Directions to the Hall**

From A35 follow direction signs for Wareham.  
 Take the A351 (Wareham bypass) signposted Swanage.  
 Continue about 2½ miles to the roundabout showing  
 Furzebrook to the right and Corfe Castle straight ahead.  
 Take the third exit toward Furzebrook and Blue Pool.  
 Furzebrook Village Hall will be seen on the right hand  
 side in about ¼ mile

Satnav users enter postcode BH20 5AR

The event will be run under rules and guidance laid down by the UK Government at the time. In particular it may be necessary to wear masks and we may ask you take a lateral flow test before attending.  
 During the planning process we will try to leave as much room as possible between teams and ringers - so there will be a limit on the number of people allowed into the event.  
 On the day we will maximise the available ventilation.  
 Those booking will receive an email acknowledging that they have been accepted and will be allocated the space they have requested on this booking form or a notification that they have not been successful.

Individuals attending are asked to bring their own bells if possible with a piece of foam. Please note that if you use marked music you need to bring a pair of bells as shown opposite as our music is marked in that pairing.  
 There will be a limited number of Regional bells available for anyone unable to bring their own; please email requests to [john@torbells.plus.com](mailto:john@torbells.plus.com) as soon as possible.  
 Teams attending are asked to bring their own tables if at all possible, otherwise please sketch your requirements on the reverse of the booking form.
