Directions:

- From the west. At M5 junction 23 take the A39 toward Glastonbury and Wells and at the first roundabout take the second turning (signposted Gravity) into Enterprise Way. At the next roundabout (approx. $\frac{3}{4}$ mile) take the third exit into Woolavington Road. The hall will be seen on the right in about a mile.
- From the east - follow the A39 toward Bridgwater. At the junction with the B3141 turn right toward Highbridge and Woolavington. In 1 mile turn left into Higher Road and the entrance to the hall is on the left.
- Refunds will be made for anyone who has paid but is not able to attend on the day.
