Directions to the hall (SATNAV users enter postcode TA3 7JZ)

From the West: Leave the M5 at junction 26 and follow the A38 toward Taunton. After 4 miles go straight across the Silk Mills roundabout then turn right on to Galmington Road. In about 3 miles at the T junction, turn right into Trull Road; in about ½ mile (at the end of the Queens College 20mph zone) bear left into Wild Oak Lane; at the end turn left into Church Road and the car park entrance is on the right (opposite the church).

From the East: At Junction 25 of the M5, follow the A358/A38 toward Musgrove Park Hospital. At Compass Hill bear left into Trull Road (signposted Trull and Blagdon) for about 1½ miles. At the end of the Queens College 20mph zone bear left into Wild Oak Lane; at the end turn left into Church Road and the car park entrance is on the right (opposite the church).
