Directions:

Broadhembury is equidistant from Honiton and Cullompton (approx 5 miles)

From the North and M5 (best route): Leave the M5 at junction 28 Take the A373 signed Honiton; in about 5 miles turn left (signposted Broadhembury 1 mile) and just before entering the village, the Memorial Hall is on the left.

Alternatively from Honiton: Take A373 from Honiton; in about 5 miles turn right (signposted Broadhembury 1 mile), stay on this road and just before entering the village, the Memorial Hall is on the left
